Critical to the long-term conservation of wilderness-worthy public lands is engagement of a broad and diverse public. To that end, AWC is launching an array of new projects aimed at involving a broader range of wilderness supporters:

- Partnering with Native American Student Services at Northern Arizona University to provide students with **an exceptional learn-and-work experience** in Kendrick Mountain Wilderness
- **Joining with Veterans** in a stewardship project in the highly biodiverse Huachuca Mountains

- Restoring access to Skeleton Canyon, site of important Apache and western history, in the Peloncillo Mountains
- Providing college students with an "Alternative to Spring Break" wilderness work trip to restore remote trails in the Mazatzal Wilderness, a team effort with the Arizona Trail Association
- Collaborating with Friends of the Tonto National Forest, Arizona Trail Association and Tonto National Forest to **restore habitat for threatened and sensitive species** in Arnett Creek
